

**Housatonic Valley Regional High School
2024-2025 Asbestos Management Plan Update**

Notice to Parents, Faculty, and Staff

Since 1986, a formal Asbestos Management Program has been in place at Housatonic Valley Regional High School. The purpose of this program is to identify any Asbestos-Containing Building Material (ACBM) that may be in our school, and to take the necessary steps to ensure this material does not present an exposure hazard to students, faculty, or staff.

The Asbestos Management Program is implemented through the Housatonic Valley Regional High School Asbestos Management Plan. The plan identifies the locations of ACBM in our school and details the ongoing management program. The plan also includes descriptions of previous asbestos-containing sections and our plans for repair or removal of damaged asbestos-containing materials.

The ACBM listed in the management plan is inspected every six months to assure early detection of problem areas. Furthermore, the school is completely reinspected once every three years by a Connecticut licensed asbestos inspector to make sure all ACBM is properly identified and that the Asbestos Management Plan is up to date.

The Housatonic Valley Regional High School Asbestos Management Plan is maintained in the school office. Additionally, a complete set of the Region One Asbestos Management Plans are maintained in the Superintendent's Office at 246 Warren Turnpike Road, Falls Village, Connecticut. These plans are available for review during normal business hours.
